The reproduction of musical works is one of the rights – set out in the Copyright Act – that requires you to notify the copyright owner and pay the appropriate royalties. AMCOS - through its membership-base and reciprocal agreements with overseas copyright collecting societies – provides access to a vast number of local and international musical works.
